BAHT Level I



Aims

The BAHT Level I course aims to provide and opportunity for healthcare workers to gain an insight into the hand, its structure and function and the application of assessment and rehabilitation principles to common injuuri3es and conditions affecting the hand. It also aims to provide occupational therapists and physiotherapists the opportunity to complete their first step on the route to becoming a BAHT AHT, gaining 1 BAHT point on successful completion of the post-course assessment.

Objectives

By the end of the course, the participants should be able to:

- Demonstrate and understanding of the pure and functional anatomy of the hand
- Describe the rationale for and application of common methods of hand assessment
- Describe the rational for recording assessment, objectives and outcomes in a clear, comprehensive and concise manner
- Demonstrate basic knowledge of some commonly seen hand injuries and conditions
- Recognise commonly encountered complications resulting from hand injury or pathology
- Demonstrate a basic understanding and evaluation of treatment methods commonly utilised in the management of hand injuries and conditions
- Complete the Level I course examination online within two weeks of the course completion date
