## **Introduction to Virtual NES BAHT Validated Level II Courses**

This guide will help you navigate your way through the etiquette and course guidelines for NES BAHT Level II virtual courses. We look forward to welcoming you online.

- We will send you a WeTransfer link to the manual to download. You have to click this link for two weeks and need to download and save it onto your computer within the two weeks. It is totally up to you whether you want to print a copy or use it on a screen.
  - We have provided a separate file of documents we recommend you print
    - The anatomy workbook
    - The pictures of the off the shelf splints
    - Sensory assessment charts
- We will run a Pre-course welcome session, **which is optional** for you. This will run on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> May at 19.00 – 19.30. We will be there online so that you can join us and see how the Zoom classroom will work and, again, reassure yourself that you know your way around Zoom. We will send you a separate Zoom link for this session.
- Please ensure you are in a space where you can be left alone so you can fully participate.
  - From our experience it can be very challenging having to participate on a virtual course from your work place, if your employer is insisting you participate at work please contact us so that we can discuss this with you.
- Please have the box of goodies we sent to you to hand throughout the course.
- We have also sent you a list of items that we suggest you have available. Please collect these from around the house and have them to hand.
- We will be doing a formal registration in the mornings, but we will also be checking regularly that everyone is online as this is a BAHT requirement.
- We have built short breaks in between most of the sessions as we realise watching a screen solidly for three days is exhausting. Please try to time your comfort breaks and fetching of drinks / snacks in these breaks. There are longer tea / coffee / lunch breaks.
- The BAHT rep will be present on the last day to answer any questions about BAHT or for you to feedback about the running of the course etc.
- Please see the information on the BAHT examination process for virtual courses – found on the resources section of our website. We will discuss it with you on the first day where we will give you a link to sample questions so that you can go into our portal and see how it looks as you go through questions. We will let you have access to this portal
